The swimming pool at Cranleigh Leisure Centre is now open so take advantage of free swimming for under 16's at all Waverley Leisure Centres – see the back page for details of how to apply. Don't forget our local parks and open spaces – details of local play areas, ball courts and skateboard parks can be found at www.waverley.gov.uk. The Downs Link is easily accessible for cycling, riding, walking, buggies and wheelchairs and the nearest parking can be found at Bramley old Station and Cranleigh Village Way car park. Blackheath Common, Chinthurst Hill, Winterfold and Pitch Hill provide a range of locally accessible woodland walks for all ages.

We are also pleased to highlight the following courses and talks open to parents across the confederation schools next term:

 **THE PARENTING PUZZLE** – Raising children can be puzzling at times, but puzzles have solutions – and the Parenting Puzzle provides them. The Parenting Puzzle is a 10-week parenting course that encourages parents and carers to enjoy bringing up children so they learn to handle both their feelings and their behaviour. The course is informal, fun and a great confidence booster. Our courses are run by Cranleigh C of E Primary School in partnership with the Christopher Robin SureStart Childrens' Centre in Cranleigh. These are open to parents and carers of children of all ages. The next course will be starting at the beginning of next term in the evening 7pm – 9.15pm at Christopher Robin Nursery, Parsonage Road, Cranleigh.

 **THE STRENGTHENING FAMILIES PROGRAMME** – We are pleased to introduce this programme for parents and youths making the transition to secondary school this year. The programme has been acclaimed across the UK as a highly successful intervention in supporting families through what can be a difficult period and beyond this, building on communication between parents/carers and their adolescent children and giving them strategies to get through the trials of the teenage years together. Parent(s) and youths attend a session separately then all come together for a family session at the end of the evening. Check out the website www.mystrongfamily.org for more information. We are being supported by the 'Think Family' project to run the programme with the confederation from 6th May for 7 weekly evening sessions. There is no cost to families taking part in this project.

 **KNOW-IT-ALL FOR PARENTS** – We will be running our 'SMART Rules' internet safety workshops for pupils in years 2, 4, 6 and 8 during the summer term and as part of this would invite all parents to a very informative 'Know It All for Parents' session on 14th June, 7.30pm at Park Mead Primary School. The session highlights the gap that exists between children's real experience online and adult awareness of these experiences. The session highlights the positive ways young people are using different technologies, what the risks are to users and it outlines practical advice in avoiding or minimising risks when using online and mobile technologies. This thought-provoking session is strongly recommended and open to parents and carers with children of all ages.

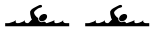
